

# Approved Face Covering Required Indoors

- Once inside the venue, all attendees must wear an approved face covering that covers the nose and mouth for the duration of the event.
  - If you need to uncover your nose or mouth at any time, we ask that you kindly step outside the venue. An usher will be glad to re-admit you when you are masked.

UC Santa Cruz requires that everyone, regardless of vaccination status, wear a face covering when accessing shared campus indoor spaces, particularly those that are open to the general public.

A face covering is defined by Cal/OSHA as a surgical mask, a medical procedure mask, a respirator worn voluntarily, or a tightly woven fabric or non-woven material of at least two layers.

A face covering has no visible holes or openings and must cover the nose and mouth.

Masks with exhalation valves or vents are not acceptable.

A face covering does not include:

a scarf, ski mask, balaclava, bandana, turtleneck, collar, or single layer of fabric.
